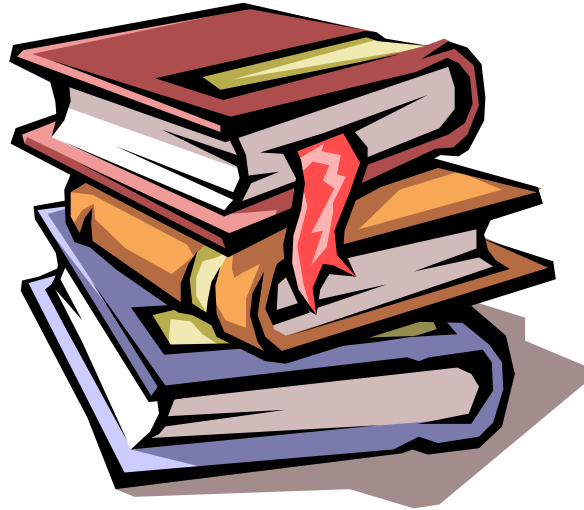


KCMPI Community Service Committee 2nd Quarter Project



Reach Out and Read Literacy Program

Mission Reach Out and Read Kansas City seeks to promote children's literacy through the participation of pediatric health care providers, volunteers, community partners, and parents, by stimulating early brain development and enhancing language and pre-reading skills. Mission Reach Out and Read Kansas City is affiliated with KU Children's Center and Children's Mercy Hospital and Clinics - www.kcreads.org.

Three Essential Components of the program:

1. In clinic waiting rooms, trained volunteers share books with children and model reading-aloud techniques for parents.
2. In exam rooms, doctors and nurse practitioners "prescribe" reading and counsel parents on how to use books to support their child's healthy development.
3. At each well-child visit, children 6 months through 5 years receive a new, developmentally and culturally appropriate book to take home.
